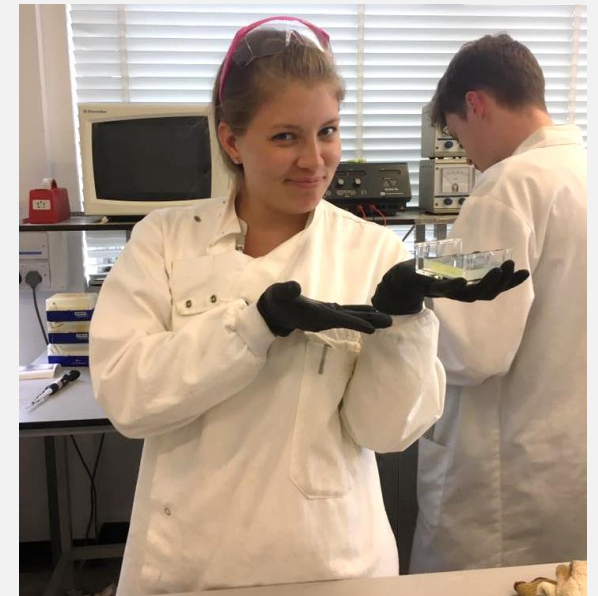
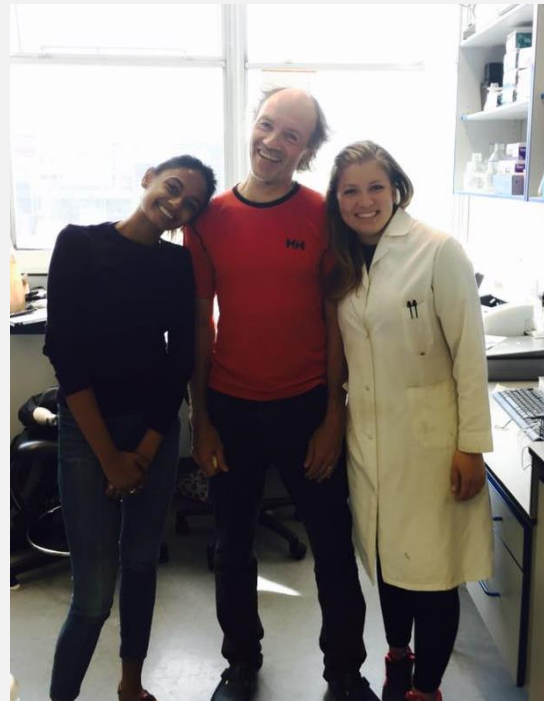
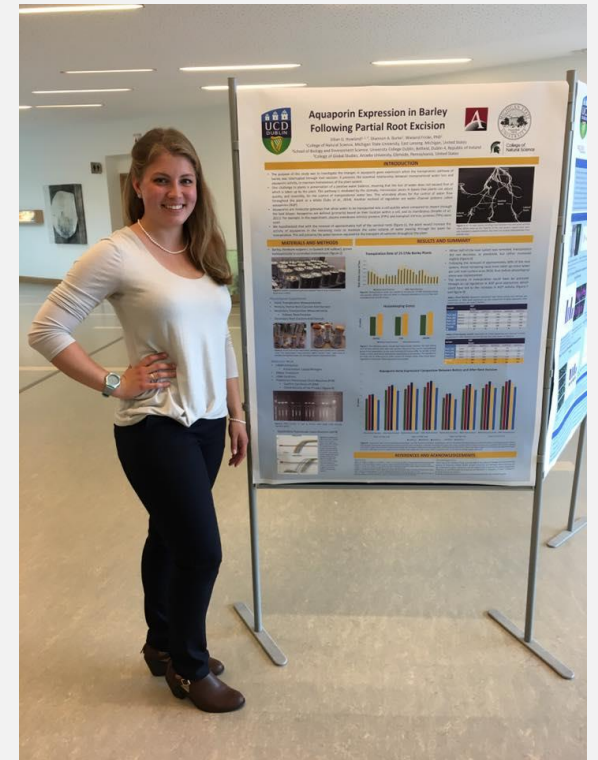
EDUCATION ABROAD

- Water-channel protein expression before and after physiological stress of barley



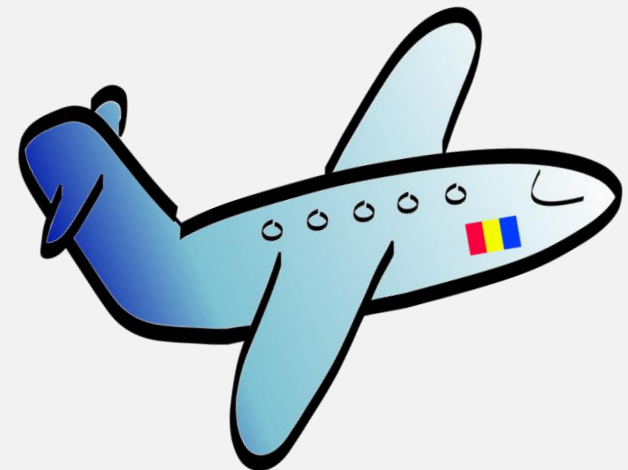
PROFESSIONAL GOALS

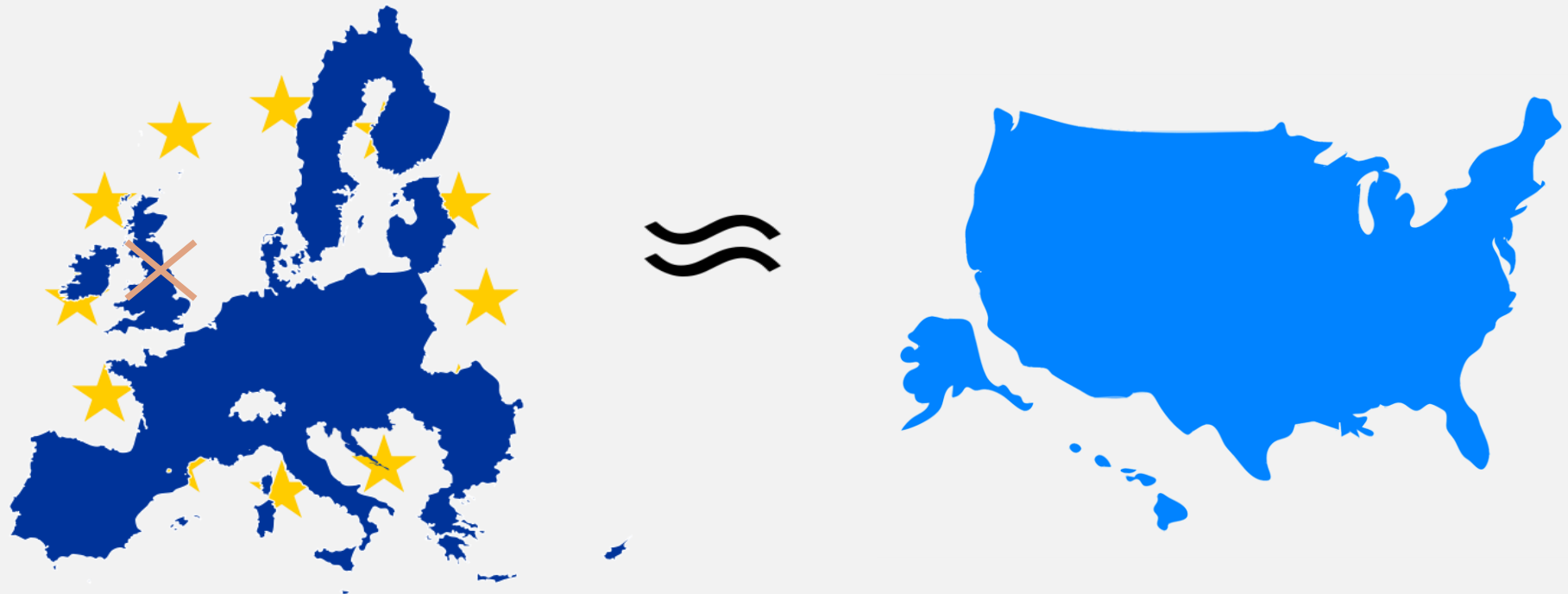
PERSONAL GOALS

 - Feeling of belonging



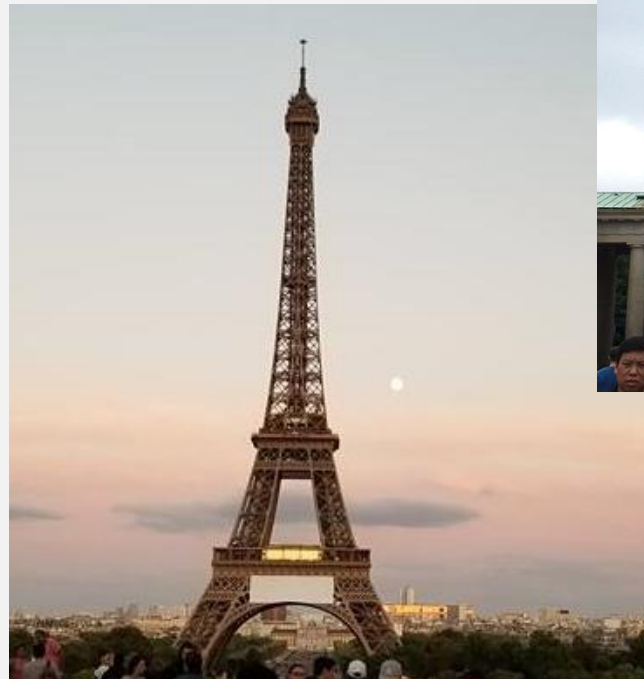


BEING A FOREIGNER

Stereotyped

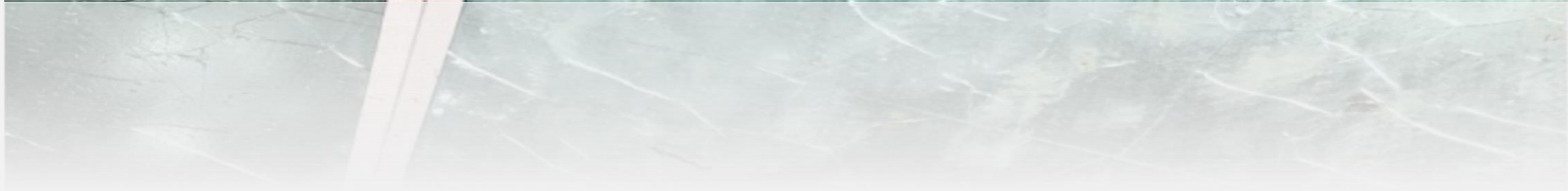
- Loud & Generous
