## The Associate Provost for Undergraduate Education (APUE) and the Office for Education Abroad (EA) Undergraduate Research Study Abroad Program Scholarship

The APUE and EA Research Study Abroad Program Scholarship provides financial support for undergraduate MSU students to participate in approved accredited education abroad programs that have an undergraduate research component. Applicants must be MSU undergraduate students with a cumulative GPA of 2.75 or higher at the time of application and have applied for a research study abroad program as described below. Students who do not meet the minimum GPA will not be considered. Applicants must also be undergraduates at the time of the study abroad program.

The study abroad program in which they participate:

- Must be credit granting and on the list of approved undergraduate research study abroad programs: <a href="http://educationabroad.isp.msu.edu/students/research/approved-programs-research-abroad/">http://educationabroad.isp.msu.edu/students/research/approved-programs-research-abroad/</a>
- Must include a research component, defined as including scholarly, creative, and artistic
  activities that lead to new knowledge, improve problem solving capabilities, offer original
  or historical theory and interpretation, and/or produce art or creative performances.
- Only students participating in independent study projects must submit a letter or recommendation from their research mentor outlining, in detail, the research experience, purpose of the project, and any products the student will submit upon their return. Independent studies will be approved on a case by case basis.
   \*Letters of recommendation must be submitted by the application deadline

## Financial need is not a factor in awarding this scholarship.

To be considered, submit your application and essay to the MSU Office for Education Abroad by the following application deadlines:

- Friday, October 19, 2018, for spring 2019
- Friday, March 1, 2019, for summer & fall 2019 and academic year 2019-20 programs

Scholarships of \$500 will be awarded to recipients chosen by a scholarship review committee. For spring applicants, winners will notified by Friday, November 16, 2018. Winners will be announced by Friday, April 5, 2019, for summer, fall and academic year programs.
